Tuesday, January 1

Got up very early, had my breakfast, turned the poor kitten out of doors, took my lantern as far as Alfred Miller, got Polie to "set" me over the river ford, and walked to Toxaway, where I took the train and came to Tryon, where I am being royally entertained by the Howes' and Connors.

Wednesday, Jan. 2

Spent the forenoon in calling on Tryon friends, then took the noon train for Asheville.

Met Mr. Smith of Highlands and we went to the Opera together tonight.

It has been cloudy and chilly all day and tonight's paper tells of extreme cold in the north, and I am almost afraid Kate will not start.

Thursday, Jan. 3

Spent considerable time today at French Broad Press office.

Went to train after dinner but no Kate and Dewey came, much to my disappointment. Tonight I went to the telegraph office to send a message. I found one had been chasing me all about, saying Kate's father was sick and she could not come now. Mr. Smith and I went to the opera again.

Friday, Jan. 4

Walked out to Biltmore and up the Swannanoa river a ways this forenoon. It has turned off cool and cleared up.

This afternoon I took the train and came to Brevard. Met a Michigan man on the cars.

Am stopping with Mr. Hellan at the Franklin.

Saturday, Jan. 5

Did some business in Brevard this morning, then took the train and came up to Toxaway and walked to Sapphire. Had supper with Mr. Carson at the Inn and then came home, stopping a few minutes at Burlingames to get my house key.

Muldoon was glad to see me.

Sunday, Jan. 6 Ther.: 28+, 42+

Been pretty close at home all day as my head ached from the living I have had while away.

Wrote a letter to me. Called at Burlingames this evening.

Monday, Jan. 7

It was cloudy and looked very stormy this morning but cleared up shortly after noon.

Went to Sapphire this afternoon to mail some letters and see if there was any word from Kate, but there was no letters from Michigan.

The clock Kate bought had come and I brought it home, but found it was so injured that it may be useless.

Tuesday, Jan. 8

I suppose Kate and Dewey are on their way home as I got no message today to the contrary, but had a card from ma saying they expected to start. I got at the new clock this morning and fixed it so it seems to be running all right. Had supper at Mr. Burlingames tonight.

It has been cloudy all day and almost rainy some of the time, but there are some stars out tonight.

Wednesday, Jan. 9

This has been a most beautiful day.

I went over to Sapphire early this morning and rode to Toxaway with Mr. Gee, where I took the train and went to Asheville to meet Kate and Dewey. I found them in the sleeping car from Cincinnati. We got to Brevard tonight and are stopping with Mr. and Mrs. Heelan at The Franklin Inn.

Thursday, Jan. 10

It started in raining last night and has kept it up all day and we gave up going to Sapphire today. Dewey has been feeling miserable but seems better tonight.

Friday, Jan. 11

The heavy rain continues, but we took the train to Toxaway and we had a 4 horse carriage up to Sapphire through the rain, then I walked over home and they brought Kate and Dewey over in a carriage. We found things all right and my long lone spell is at an end. The rain has raised the rivers and creeks very high.

Saturday, Jan. 12

It stopped raining toward morning and cleared off cool and breezy.

I set up the stove in the shop this forenoon.

Mr. Albert Stolzenbach was with us to dinner, and Mr. and Mrs. Cordally called this afternoon.

I went to Sapphire for the mail. Had a letter from ma. She was so lonesome when Dewey and Kate left.

Sunday, Jan. 13

Been a fine day.

We called at Burlingames this afternoon.

Dewey seems better of his cold.

Monday, Jan. 14

Went to Sapphire with mail this morning and sent ma \$3.00 to get a rocking chair for her birthday. Mr. Albert Stolzenbach came home with me and stayed a while. He starts back for Pittsburg tomorrow. Went to Alfred Millers and got some corn meal this afternoon.

Developed a lot of films tonight.

Tuesday, Jan. 15

Been a beautiful day.

Did considerable photo printing.

Mrs. Carson and their two boarders called toward evening.

Wednesday, Jan. 16

Did some slicking up around the house but there is much more to do. Finished up a batch of photos this afternoon. It has been quite warm.

Thursday, Jan. 17

Spent the forenoon at Sapphire doing some special portrait work.

It was cloudy this forenoon, but cleared up this afternoon and is growing cold tonight.

Mrs. D. Miller gave Kate a hen today.

Friday, Jan.18

Ther.: 10+, 26+,18+

Been the coldest day of winter so far. We put up the little heating stove this morning to help the fireplace. I finished a batch of photos today and went to Sapphire tonight to deliver some work to tourists who leave tomorrow.

It is cold and windy tonight.

Saturday, Jan. 19 Ther.: 26+, 56+, 32+

It was very windy last night, but grew warmer and has been very pleasant today.

Mr. and Mrs. Carson took dinner with us and spent some little time. We enjoyed having them here very much.

I went over to Dr. Grimshawes toward evening.

Sunday, Jan. 20

Been a beautiful day.

Mr. Burlingame called this forenoon.

Kate has had a hard headache.

Monday, Jan. 21

Went to the store and Post office this morning.

Made some Sepia prints today.

Kate and I put leaves on the strawberry bed to protect it from frost. It clouded up and sprinkled a little toward night.

Tuesday, Jan. 22

Been a clear beautiful day. I cut up some wood, fixed about the cellar, and finished cleaning out from under the house.

Mr. and Mrs. Duffield called on us this afternoon.

Wednesday, Jan. 23

The weather was changeable today, being cloudy, then clear, and cloudy with some sprinkling toward evening.

Kate and Dewey went over to Burlingames and I went to carry the boy home. Made a batch of photos.

Thursday, Jan. 24

It rained all last night and this forenoon. I chopped down a goodsized green oak tree this afternoon to use for fire wood.

It is clear and cooler tonight.

Friday, Jan. 25 Ther.: 16+, 30+

The wind blew very hard last night and it grew cold.

Could not work at photos today because of high wind. Fixed boards about the house so the wind could not blow under it.

Kept up the fires and wrote some business letters. Went to the store but got no mail as the mail boy did not go today.

Saturday, Jan. 26 Ther.: 30+

It grew warmer today and there were some slight showers. Mr. Dave Miller worked for me and we used my crosscut saw some. Worked at wood cutting about all day.

Called at Burlingames tonight and got our mail.

Hiram Glover writes that he is thinking of coming up here next summer.

Sunday, Jan. 27

It rained last night and most of this forenoon then turned pleasant and grew cool. Tonight it is blowing and snowing and getting quite cold.

Dewey stood looking solemnly out of the window for a long time and when I asked him what he wanted he said "Gom-pe and Gom-me." He seems to get lonesome at times.

Monday, Jan. 28

Cold and very windy all day. Did some photo printing this afternoon.

Tuesday, Jan. 29

Warmer today and cloudy. Tonight it is snowing some. Finished photos and sawed some wood.

Called at Burlingames tonight for the mail.

Wednesday, Jan. 30

Ground covered with snow this morning but it all melted before night.

Went to Sapphire with mail this morning.

Cut up some wood this afternoon.

It is clear tonight.

Dewey talks a good deal about the home folks.

Thursday, Jan. 31 Ther.: 20+, 28+, 18+

Been quite cold all day. I drew one end of a cross cut most of the day.

Went to Sapphire this evening for the mail.

It is real sharp tonight.

Friday, February 1 Ther.: 22+, 38+, 32+

Been a very nice day.

I did considerable cleaning up about the yard.

Saturday, Feb. 2

Turned some warmer and has been cloudy most of the day.

Kate and I fixed some shelves in the kitchen so as to have things more handy.

When Dewey finished his meals he always says "Has I got froo I dinna, eh!"

Sunday, Feb. 3

Snow covered the ground this morning, but it has rained all day and about taken it off.

Dewey wanted to go and see his grandpa and grandma today, and has acted very lonesome.

Been reading and resting all day.

Monday, Feb. 4 Ther.: 32+, 28+

Been cool, windy and clear all day.

Mr. Miller was here and we used the cross cut saw to good advantage.

Dewey said he was too "busee" to eat.

Tuesday, Feb. 5

Been a very fine day.

I helped Mr. Miller and we cut down the big hemlock tree back of the shop. I did not like to lose it so but it threatened my shop if it should blow down. Went over to Burlingames and got the mail tonight. Had a letter from Will and he talks of leaving the old home and going to work on an Electric railway. It seems as though the home place was going to be deserted in time.

Wednesday, Feb. 6

Another beautiful day. Helped saw up some wood. Kate and Dewey spent most of the day at Burlingames. I went to Sapphire this afternoon to take views over to the office.

Thursday, Feb. 7

Been cloudy all day, threatening to snow. There was one squall of very large snow flakes just after dinner.

Worked at the wood again today.

Friday, Feb. 8

Been cloudy and foggy all day. Rains tonight.

Called to see how Mr. Burlingame was this evening. He seems to have the grip.

Mr. D. Miller and I sawed up more wood.

Saturday, Feb. 9

Been a very nice day. Mr. Burlingame and I went over to Dr. Grimshawes this morning. Diptheria is again raging in the Bohana district again. Went to Sapphire this afternoon to get the mail and do errands.

Sunday, Feb. 10 Ther.: 58+

Been very pleasant and warm. Kate, Dewey and I took a walk over the gap to our "Maple Corner" this forenoon.

Mrs. Jacobs and some others called on us this afternoon.

It has clouded up tonight.

Monday, Feb. 11

We had a snow storm this morning which made the ground white for a while, but it went off with a sort of drizzle.

This afternoon I went to Sapphire and made some portraits. Got a letter from ma and she writes of a big snow they had a weed ago.

Tuesday, Feb. 12

I saw a fire over toward Sapphire last night which I took for a camp fire, but it was the start of the burning of one of the hotel cottages, with great loss to those who had things in it.

Mr. Miller and I sawed up considerable wood today.

It has been quite fair, but is cloudy tonight. Wednesday, Feb. 13 Been a beautiful day. Fixed up fencing today. Kate had Mr. Millers horse this afternoon and made a call at the hotel. Thursday, Feb. 14 Another fine day. Had Mr. Miller burn brush heaps and work at cleaning yard. Printed photos. Kate had Dewey out in the yard for a good airing. Had a letter from ma and they have had more snow and drifts. Friday, Feb. 15 Went down below Mr. Toxaway to the saw mill and made a number of views. One was of lowering logs over a 175 foot cliff. Pretty tired tonight from the long walk. Been a nice day. Saturday, Feb. 16 Developed plates exposed yesterday. Fires are creeping up on the south and so I started a back fire this evening. Miss Brown and Lucy Burlingame were here to supper. A fine day. Sunday, Feb. 17 Been a beautiful day. Stayed close at home. Wrote several letters and orders for goods. Monday, Feb. 18 Another nice day. Went to Sapphire this morning to mail letters and do some errands. Marked some negatives and did considerable printing.

Tuesday, Feb. 19

Worked at finishing photos.

The wind has blown quite hard and it has grown colder.

Wednesday, Feb. 20 Ther.: 10+, 28+, 16+

Been a cold day.

I fear the peach crop will be killed for this year.

The ground was white with snow this morning, but the sun melted the most of it during the day.

Took a lot of photos over to the office this morning.

Dewey and I did some cleaning up in the yard.

Thursday, Feb. 21 Ther.: 10+, 28+

Cold this morning but moderated during the day.

Kate and Dewey called on the Burlingames while I went over town for the mail.

Friday, Feb. 22 Ther.: 22+, 24+

Windy and squally.

Finished a batch of photos.

Called at Burlingames and got the mail this evening.

Dewey was lonesome and talked of the folks at home.

Saturday, Feb. 23 Ther.: 23+, 14+

We had a sort of fitful snow storm this forenoon, making the ground white.

Went to Dr. Grimshawe's this forenoon, and while I was away Mr. McGriffin who was here 4 years ago when we lived at Sapphire, called. He and friend are coming tomorrow again.

Went to Sapphire for the mail and some oil.

Sunday, Feb. 24 Ther.: 6+, 34+, 28+

The coldest this morning that it has been, but a fine day.

Mr. McGriffin and Mr. Hutton took dinner with us. They start back north this week.

Monday, Feb. 25

Ther.: 20+, 32+

Much milder today.

Wrote letters this forenoon.

Went to Sapphire this afternoon.

Tuesday, Feb. 26 Ther.: 28+, 38+, 32+

Been a fine day.

Was sick with a sort of grip.

Wednesday, Feb. 27 *Ther.:* 20+, 29+

Been a pretty nice day. Kate had Mr. Millers horse and went to Sapphire and Fairfield. Dewey and I took care of the house.

Thursday, Feb. 28 Ther.: 28+, 48+

Been a fine day and is growing warmer.

Went to Sapphire this forenoon.

Sent for a panoramic printing frame to see what I can do in that line of work.

Mr. ad Mrs. McGunken called on us. They leave the hotel tomorrow going to S.C.

Did some photo printing.

Friday, March 1

March came in something like a lion, as we had a snow squall this forenoon that made the ground white. It got warmer, rained a little, and the snow all melted. The sun shone some this afternoon. Began to salt Plain Paper. Called at Alfred Miller's to get a bundle he had brought from Whiteside Cave. We had a time getting the hens in the coop tonight.

Saturday, March 2

Ther.: 60+

Been a spring like day. Finished a batch of photos.

Went to Sapphire for mail and groceries.

Sunday, March 3 Ther.: 70+

Been real warm.

Wrote letters and read considerable.

Mr. Nixon and Mr. Warren called this afternoon.

Took a little run with Mr. Dave Miller over some fruit land of his on the east side of Rainy Knob.

Monday, March 4

Warm and considerably cloudy all day.

I burned a fire guard to the west of the place.

Kate and Dewey went to the hotel to see Mrs. Carson today.

I went over for the mail this afternoon.

We heard that Mr. Wilkinson, who was here last summer, had been shot and was dead.

Tuesday, March 5 Ther.: 14+

It was warm this morning but turned cold this afternoon and is one of the most sudden changes of the winter. I did some fixing about the yard and garden this forenoon.

Went to Sapphire toward evening.

Wednesday, March 6 Ther.: 4+, 28+, 12+

Mercury lowest of the season so far this morning.

Mr. and Mrs. Burlingame were here to dinner, and spent part of the day.

It is biting cold tonight.

Thursday, March 7 Ther.: 12+, 42+, 30+

Moderated some today. Kate, Dewey and I all worked at cleaning yard.

I went to Dr. Grimshawes this afternoon.

Friday, March 8 Ther.: 26+, 46+

Been quite pleasant. Very smoky.

Went to Sapphire this morning.

Pruned fruit trees and did some chores about house and yard.

Have a hard cold in my head and throat.

Saturday, March 9 Ther.: 40+

It began raining last night and has rained about all day.

Went over to Sapphire this evening for the mail.

I bought and planted 4 cherry trees.

Sunday, March 10

Ther.: 52+

Rainstorms about all day, some pretty hard showers. Cleared off here tonight but can see storm in the low country to southeast. We spent day in reading and writing.

Monday, March 11

Been clear and windy. Seemed to be getting cooler but was not freezing yet tonight.

Did printing and salting paper. Kate sowed some sweet peas.

Fixed ground to plant raspberry bushes.

Tuesday, March 12

Ther.: 60+

Been nice warm day.

Sprayed peach trees with cooper Sulphate to try and kill curl leaf.

Finished batch of photos this afternoon.

Wednesday, March 13

Looked like rain this forenoon, but it cleared up this afternoon. Took a lot of photos to the office to be sent to Mr. Hays. He has gone to Florida.

Salted paper and did some printing.

Dug up a patch of ground to plant some potatoes on.

Kate fixed a cold frame.

Thursday, March 14

Did some work in cleaning up the garden spot and digging up a bed for early seed sowing and a place to plant dewberry bushes.

Finished some photos and took them to Sapphire this afternoon.

Friday, March 15

Ther.: 26+

It turned cool last night and has been freezing all today with some snow squalls.

Got up some wood and did more raking and burning of rubbish.

Saturday, March 16 Ther.: 22+, 34+, 24+

Ther.. 22+, 34+, 24+

Been some squally and pretty cool all day.

Went to Sapphire this morning. Called on Mr. Carson who is sick with grip.

Built a platform at the back door.

Kate sowed onion, lettuce, and radish seed.

Sunday, March 17 Ther.: 24+, 58+, 46+

Been a very nice day and growing warmer again. I examined my peach trees and find the buds about all dead.

Monday, March 18

Been quite warm.

Dewey and I went up on the hill and planted 24 hills of potatoes this forenoon. Took up from the woods and set out near the shop some azalea I had marked last summer.

Was over at Sapphire and found Kate's goods had come.

Getting ready to start for Highlands tomorrow.

Tuesday, March 19

Came to Highlands today. Took dinner at the Grimshawes in Whiteside Cove. Called on old Col. Alley.

Put up at Rideout's. Most everybody sick with grip.

Wednesday, March 20

Began raining last night and poured all today. I called on Mr. McGee this forenoon. He and Prof. Harbison are clearing land for an apple orchard below Satulah Mt.

Thursday, March 21

Today has been very pleasant. I went to the Satulah Falls this forenoon, and to Glenn Falls this afternoon. Was on Mr. Bascom's orchard site. Many of his trees have been killed by coal tar, put on to protect them from worms. It froze some last night and has been pretty cool all day.

Friday, March 22

Quite pleasant today.

Froze very hard last night. Had to break ice in pitcher this morning.

Went to photograph some Falls on the Cullasague river this afternoon. Made several calls. Warmer tonight.

Saturday, March 23

Left Highlands this morning as soon as could see well. Went by Horse Cove to see a new lake. Also visited "Granite City" to photograph rocks. Made a call at Grimshawe's but did not stay to dinner because of threatened storm. The rain caught me before I got home and made it hard traveling the last mile. Found folks well.

Sunday, March 24

Been rather foggy all day.

Called at Burlingames this forenoon.

Monday, March 25

Rained last night and all today, sometimes very hard.

I developed all the plates I exposed on the Highlands trip. Lucy Burlingame is here helping Kate now.

We played a game of dominoes tonight and Dewey was much interested.

Tuesday, March 26

Rained very hard all last night and early this morning, then it began to clear and has been a nice day. I took my camera and went to the Whitewater Falls which was a fine sight today. Took dinner with Mr. Marshall's folks.

Wednesday, March 27

Went to Sapphire this forenoon to collect some money and say good bye to Mr. and Mrs. Carson who intend to leave tomorrow.

Set out 12 young peach trees and made places to set some apple and nut trees.

Kate did some printing this afternoon. It was faire till about night when clouds blew up and it sprinkled a little.

Thursday, March 28

Put out the young apple and nut trees.

Kate sowed some early peas.

Had a letter from ma. Pa is not well any more.

Had Lucy finish some photos this afternoon.

Quite cool tonight.

Thursday, March 29

Burnished the photos this morning. Did a lot of writing.

Was visited by some men who are stopping at the hotel.

It has been some cloudy all day and looks rainy tonight. Warmer.

Saturday, March 30

It has been a damp and misty day. It rained last night.

I went to Sapphire this forenoon to make a settlement all around. Had a chat with Mr. Hays who is here now.

Planted out some Dewberry bushes in the garden.

Sunday, March 31

This has been a bright day.

Have been quiet all day.

Monday, April 1

Kate was 40 years old today.

I went to Sapphire this morning to make some photos.

It was pleasant early this morning, then got cloudy and this afternoon it rained, hailed, and snowed, but has settled down to raining tonight.

Tuesday, April 2 Ther.: 34+, 34+, 40+

It rained all last night, and there has been a cold rain all today. Tonight there are signs of clearing up. The top of Mt. Toxaway seemed to be covered with ice.

Did some housecleaning in my shop.

Wednesday, April 3

Been windy and quite cool all day and I fear it will freeze some tonight.

Dewey is somewhat sick with a hard cold.

Dave Miller came to work for me.

Kate and I both finished photos.

Thursday, April 4

There was some ice this morning, but it has warmer up and I don't think anything is hurt.

Dewey was taken with a fainting spell this morning and I went o Dr. Grimshawe's for medicine. He is better tonight. Went to Sapphire this afternoon. The Stolzenbachs have just came from Pittsburg.

Friday, April 5

Spent most of the day working with Mr. Miller fixing logs and stoners below fruit trees.

Dewey has a very bad cold.

Some clouds and some sunshine.

Saturday, April 6

I went to Sapphire this morning and took over some views.

It has been cloudy, cool, and windy, almost like a snow.

Dewey's cold is very bad. It seemed as though he would have croup last night.

Sunday, April 7

Been a bright, fine day.

Mr. Burlingame and I went over to Dr. Grimshawe's this forenoon.

Dewey was pretty sick last night but seems some better tonight.

Monday, April 8

Been a fine day.

Worked at pictures all day.

Kate had a letter from ma, and pa is in very poor health.

White frost this morning.

Tuesday, April 9

The ground was a little frozen this morning.

Went to Sapphire tonight.

Wednesday, April 10

Been warmer today. Kate did the Photo work and I washed apple trees.

Dewey still has a bad cough.

Mr. Arthur Miller brought us a barrel of flour.

Thursday, April 11

Nice, pleasant day.

Kate and I worked at photos about all day.

Washed a few more apple trees.

Friday, April 12

Went over to Sapphire this morning. Quite a number left the hotel. I worked most of the day in the upper orchard.

It clouded up during the day and began raining tonight.

I have a toothache on hand tonight.

Saturday, April 13

Did not sleep any last night because of the toothache.

It has rained and snowed all day. The mountain tops are white with snow tonight.

Have been in the house all day.

Sunday, April 14

Snow on top of Mt. Toxaway about all day. Kate went home with Lucy this forenoon and got the mail.

It has not stormed today, but has been somewhat cloudy.

Monday, April 15

Been warmer and quite pleasant.

Went to Sapphire this forenoon. Called on Mr. Gus Gee who has a badly broken leg. Made a place for a new strawberry bed. Called at Arthur Millers and paid for a barrel of flour, then went to Alfred Miller's and got a sack of corn meal. Mr. D. Miller brought the shingles for our new porch.

Tuesday, April 16

Been a fine day.

Kate made Photo-Etchings and I experimented with the Panoramic printing frame.

Dewey was out door a good deal.

A skunk under the house does not add to our pleasure, though he seems to enjoy the place and had a great play with the china nest egg.

Wednesday, April 17

Been nice and warm but partially cloudy all day.

Kate sick all forenoon with headache, but out saking yard this afternoon.

I set about 60 new strawberry plants.

Finished photos this afternoon.

Thursday, April 18

Been cloudy all day and threatening rain which has begun tonight.

I fixed up the background on the porch and took portraits of Kate, Dewey and Lucy.

Did developing and printing on Bromik paper.

Friday, April 19

We are having another freshet. It rained all last night and all today, and the streams are very full.

I retouched and proofed the plates I made yesterday.

Went to Sapphire this afternoon for kerosene and the mail.

It still rains tonight.

Saturday, April 20

Ther.: 29+

The rain last night turned to snow and the ground was white this morning. A heavy wind has blown all day, and it is a sort of blizzard tonight, and freezing. I fear the cold will do lots of damage.

Didn't do much but saw wood and build fires.

Sunday, April 21 Ther.: 26+, 32+

Been cold and dismal all day.

Snow still remains on the northern mountain tops.

Peach blossoms are probably all killed.

Monday, April 22 Ther.: 28+, 24+

Been cloudy all day. Tonight it is snowing hard, but it is not cold.

Went to Sapphire and got the mail this afternoon.

Cannot do any photo work.

Tuesday, April 23 Ther.: 34+

Every thing was white with snow this morning. It clung to all the trees and bushes making a very wintry look. It stopped snowing and it all melted by noon except on the mountain tops.

Printed photos.

Kate and Dewey did more cleaning up in the yard.

Wednesday, April 24

Been a very pleasant day.

Mr. Miller plowed our garden today.

Went to Sapphire this evening for the mail and to get a sack of oatmeal.

Thursday, April 25

A nice, bright day for the most part. Kate worked at finishing photos and I helped Arthur Miller put on the roof to our back porch.

Wednesday, April 26

Been a nice day.

Went to Sapphire this morning and got the remainder of my oatmeal. Finished the work on the little porch. Kate finished photos.

We planted some sweet corn this evening, and Mr. Burlingame brought us some early cabbage plants.

Saturday, April 27

Beautiful weather.

Set some hitching posts and did odd jobs this afternoon. Had a letter from Hiram this evening. He has shipped the tent. Sunday, April 28 Nice day. Wrote letters this forenoon. Went to Sapphire and Fairfield this afternoon. Kate and Dewey had to stay alone at home. Monday, April 29 Clear and warm. We worked hard at photo finishing. Kate finished here first mess of Platino. Tuesday, April 30 Been warm day. Worked in orchard and garden. Went to Post Office after supper. Kate made batch of prints. She set out some tomato plants this evening. Read, wrote and slept.

Monday, June 3

Saturday, Nov. 16 Ther.: 18+, 23+

Been freezing all day. Covered the strawberry beds for the winter.

Went to Sapphire this afternoon.

Sunday, Nov. 17 Ther.: 20+ Not so cold and growing warmer. I went up on Rainy Knob Mt. with Mr. Dave Miller this forenoon. We were looking for a place to locate Hiram Glover if possible.

Monday, Nov. 18 Ther. 27+

Sawed fireplace wood all day. Had Mr. D. Miller with me. It is warmer but still chilly.

Tuesday, Nov. 19 Ther.: 24+

The ground was white with snow this morning and it threatened storm till afternoon. It is clear and chilly tonight.

I salted paper.

Went to Sapphire this evening.

Wednesday, Nov. 20

Ther.: 42+

Been a bright day.

Working in the photo shop most of the time.

Kate made out an order to Montgomery Ward and co. for things for Christmas and I went to the post office and sent it out.

Thursday, Nov. 21 Ther.: 28+

Beautiful day.

Finished a batch of Booklets.

Dewey has a very hard cough.

Friday, Nov. 22

Pleasant until this afternoon and then it began to cloud and look like a storm.

I finished another lot of Booklets.

Went to Sapphire after supper tonight to get the mail.

Dewey still has a bad cold.

Saturday, Nov. 23

Been a stormy day. Rain and sleet. It rained hard last night.

Tonight it has cleared and is colder.

Sunday, Nov. 24

Nice day.

A team from Highlands came for me this afternoon, but I could not go. Sent my camera over though, and will go myself later.

Monday, Nov. 25

Been getting ready to leave tomorrow.

Sunday, December 1

Got ready this morning and left my dear ones at home, coming over to Highlands on foot. Stopped at Mr. Grimshawes in Whiteside Cove for dinner. Got here about 5 o'clock this evening. It was quite warm walking. The weather is very pleasant.

Monday, Dec. 2

Left Highlands by team this morning and got to Franklin this evening. Saw Mr. Ravenel this noon at Cullasaja. Mr. Harris of The Nantahala Co. takes charge of us here. Unfortunately it is raining tonight.

Tuesday, Dec. 3

Left Franklin this morning and we drove to the foot of the Nantahala Mts. I made some timber views this afternoon.

We have a house to stay in tonight but the rest of the week we expect to camp.

Wednesday, Dec. 4

We went up into the Nantahala Mountains today taking some views.

We are camping about 4000 feet about sea level.

It is snowing and the outlook is very gloomy for my work.

Our camp is of logs and we have a big fire inside at our feet.

Thursday, Dec. 5

Snow all over the ground and a cold fog hanging all about on the mountains.

We went out and took a couple of snow scenes.

Friday, Dec. 6

We broke camp this morning as it is too snowy and bad for view work. I tried a plate on our camp. We came out of the mountains by way of a trail into Georgia and back by way of the Tennessee valley to Franklin.

Saturday, Dec. 7

Been loafing at town all day.

It has been quite pleasant and we hope for some good days next week.

Had a letter from Kate tonight. I fear they are not real well.

Sunday, Dec. 8

Spent the day in Franklin. Wrote to Dewey and to pa.

Mr. Pierson and I rode the mules up on "Trimont" this afternoon to get a view of the valley and town. It is a fine sight.

Monday, Dec. 9

It rained hard today so we could not go out to the mountains and we were all badly disappointed and about to give up the trip.

It has cleared up tonight and we have some hope.

Tuesday, Dec. 10

It was pleasant and we got off at daylight this morning. We went to the foot of the Nantahala's on Coweeta Creek, and leaving the teams went directly up on top where I took several views. We did the hardest day's walking I ever spent. We camp in a log house tonight.

Wednesday, Dec. 11

Up the Nantahala's again today. I made views from Pickens nose and in some fine timber of the mountain coves. It was another hard day.

The weather holds fine.

Thursday, Dec. 12

We broke camp this morning and came out in the Tennessee Valley. I made 2 views in a timber cove. Tonight we are in Georgia and hope to reach Highlands tomorrow. It has clouded up tonight.

I wish I could hear from Kate and Dewey.

Friday, Dec. 13

Mr. Pierson and I came on to Highlands today I a drizzling rainstorm. We came over the Scaley Mt. on a fearfully rough road. It is raining very hard tonight. I got a letter from Kate written a week ago, and two letters from ma telling of a very sick spell pa was having. I am much worried about him. If it don't storm two bad I will go home tomorrow.

Saturday, Dec. 14

We have had a most terrific rain all last night and today. I could not go home as I wanted to.

The rivers are said to be higher than ever.

Sunday, Dec. 15

It turned cold late in last night, and was clear this morning. I came home on foot, finding the roads in awful shape from fallen timber and washouts. The bridges are torn up between Sapphire and Fairfield.

Found Kate and Dewey well. A letter from ma said pa was up and out again.

Monday, Dec. 16 Ther.: 12+, 12+

Cold weather has set in.

I was at Sapphire this afternoon, but no mail or telephone messages to tell how bad the storm was in other parts.

We put up the heating stove today.

Tuesday, Dec. 17 Ther.: 11+, 26+, 16+

Been a cold and somewhat disagreeable day.

I made some photo prints.

Sawed some wood for the stove.

It has snowed a little tonight.

Wednesday, Dec. 18 Ther.: 4+, 26+, 16+ Cold.

Wrote letters and did up photos to mail.

Arthur Miller brought me some corn and wheat for chicken feed that he got in S.C.

Went to Sapphire this afternoon.

A snow squall last night made the ground white.

Thursday, Dec. 19 Ther.: 17+, 25+, 19+

Cloudy most all day.

I finished a batch of platino prints.

Kate has been fixing up calendars and painting some of the photos to send away as Christmas presents.

Friday, Dec. 20 Ther.: 16+, 19+, 4+

Cold all day.

We got a lot of packages done up and I took them to mail this afternoon.

Tonight it has become intensely cold and I fear the wind is going to rise.

Saturday, Dec. 21 Ther.: 6+, 24+, 15+

Sawed wood and fussed about all day.

It has been bright and sunny all day.

I went for the mail after supper tonight. Kate had a letter from ma and they are having severe cold too.

Sunday, Dec. 22 Ther.: 22+, 32+, 26+

Been a fine day.

We all called at Burlingames this afternoon. Lucy is home for vacation.

It grows warmer and threatens stormy weather tonight.

Monday, Dec. 23 Ther.: 28+, 38+, 24+

We had a heavy snow storm today. It turned warmer.

I went to Arthur Millers this forenoon to make out a land deed but the justice failed to get there.

Began developing the Nantahala plates.

Tuesday, Dec. 24

Ther.: 34+, 58+

Been quite warm all day.

I developed a lot of plates.

Got a hemlock tree for Kate to fix up for a Christmas tree.

Went to Sapphire tonight to get the mail. They are having a tree at the school house. We hear guns in all directions celebrating.

Wednesday, Dec. 25 Ther.: 56+, 58+

Christmas and we put in a full day.

We took dinner at Burlingames.

There was a lot of children here this afternoon to see Dewey's Christmas tree and Kate had some little thing for them all.

We were all well remembered by gifts.

I am through developing and the timber views are all good.

Thursday, Dec. 26

Been a cloudy day and some rain tonight.

My Christmas gift for Kate came tonight: A Kodak so she can take snap shots of Dewey.

Friday, Dec. 27

Been a bright day. I printed the Nantahala views and developed a lot of films.

Lucy Burlingame called and took supper with us.

Saturday, Dec. 28 Ther.: 38+

Heavy rain all day.

I finished photos of Nantahala work.

Sunday, Dec. 29 Ther.: 58+

Rained hard last night.

Showered more or less today.

Seems to be clearing up tonight.

Monday, Dec. 30 Ther.: 26+, 24+ The ground was white with a light snow this morning. It only thawed where the sun shone today.

I did up the Nantahala photos and took them to Sapphire this evening to mail and express.

It is cold and the wind blows hard tonight.

Tuesday, Dec. 31 Ther.: 52+

Warmer today and very clear.

I cut wood this forenoon.

Developed films this afternoon.

We are invited to the Sapphire Inn tomorrow to take dinner with Mrs. Wooldridge.
